Optimising healthcare delivery



We have implemented a clear pathway to the delivery of services to ensure that you receive the best of care there is. Verity Healthcare provide personalized and bespoke service in meeting with your preferences, needs and wishes.

Step1

We'll arrange to visit you at home or hospital to collect as much information as possible to know you as a person, your needs and clarify care costs; possible sources of funding and any questions.

Step 2

We'll undertake care needs and risk assessment and agree how to attend to your needs and mitigate risks. A full care plan documents and the assigned carer or nurse as agreed by you and your family will be in place. You will have the chance to review all documents relating to your care before care starts.





Step 3

A fully costed care package will be in place, with all the documents and agreements completed so you will know what to expect from your care services.

Step 4

We'll carefully select a suitable nurse or carer who are trained and highly skilled; share your interest and personality and replacement staff who will step in when your main carer or nurse is off duty.

Step 5

We'll ensure that these professionals understand your needs and provide services in-line with your care and support plan. We'll ensure that all the professionals are capable of meeting your needs. Your service commences with weekly supervision visits by Care Coordinators

Step 6

There will first two-weekly review and monitoring visit by the Registered Manager and a second visit first 6-8 weeks and any changes are required.

FUNDING CARE OPTIONS

No one left behind because of funding





Many people who qualify for funding to support their medical, health and social care needs are not aware of the funding options available to them. The various funding options available to you and your loved ones are as below:

The main funding sources are from your Local Authority and NHS Continuing Healthcare Team or health insurance companies (from insurance policy you may have in place).

Different types of funding support:

Direct Payment or Budgets

A Direct Payment is fund allocated to you directly so that you have complete control of your care package and the provider you prefer.

Individual Budgets

This budget is very similar to Personal Budget, but includes other sources of funding such as Independent Living Funds, Supporting People, Disabled Facilities Grant and Access to Work and Community Equipment Services to meet your healthcare and living needs.

Personal Budgets

A Personal Budget is an allocated funds to pay for your healthcare needs. You may instruct your local authority, your family or Social Worker to spend this amount of money on your behalf, or you can receive the money yourself as a Direct Payment.

Step 4

We'll carefully select a suitable nurse or carer who are trained and highly skilled; share your interest and personality and replacement staff who will step in when your main carer or nurse is off duty.

Personal Health Budgets

A Personal Health Budget is an amount of money allocated to a person with an established health need. The Personal Health Budgets is provided by NHS in 3 different ways; National Budget, Real Budget Held by Third Party and Direct Payment.
